General Instructions:

- Please notify the office of any change in medical history. Example: chest pains, shortness of breath, arrhythmias, new medication added, recent cough/cold or recent hospitalization.
- Please notify us if you are on any Diabetic medications such as GLP1s (Example- Wegovy, Ozempic, Mounjaro, Trulicity, Byetta), or SGLT2s (Example: Jardiance, Synjardy) as these medications are typically held prior to procedure.
- Wear comfortable clothes and shoes. Grip socks will be provided.
- Leave valuables at home or with accompanying adult. All personal items will be stored in a patient belonging bag at the bedside. There are no lockers available.
- Remove all jewelry, including body piercings.
- If your screening form or medication form requires updates or changes, please call the center where your procedure is being performed.
- The entire process, from Admission to Discharge, takes about 2 hours. If the start of your procedure is delayed, we will do our best to keep you informed.
- Cell phones must be turned off prior to entry into the clinical area. To protect the privacy of our patients, **Cell phone use is NOT permitted in clinical area.**

Patient Pick Up:

You will receive anesthesia during the procedure. Anesthesia can make you dizzy, forgetful and/or sleepy therefore:

- A responsible adult, 18 years or older, must drive and/or escort you to and from your procedure.
- Bus, taxi, shuttle, or Uber/Lyft drivers **CANNOT** be your responsible driver, unless accompanied by a responsible adult 18 years or older.
- If you do not have a responsible adult to drive and/or escort you home, your procedure will be rescheduled.
- Ride availability – If you are scheduled for a procedure at **3PM or later** your ride must remain onsite for duration of procedure.

Medications:

- If you are currently taking any blood thinning medications (Example: Plavix, Pradaxa, Coumadin, Warfarin, Clopidogrel, or Lovenox), please contact your prescribing provider as these medications may be held prior to procedure.
- If you are currently taking any Diabetic medications such as GLP1s (Example- Wegovy, Ozempic, Mounjaro, Trulicity, Byetta), or SGLT2s (Example: Jardiance, Synjardy), please inform endoscopy facility as these medications will be held prior to procedure.
- Continue all prescribed medications unless otherwise instructed, including blood pressure medications and aspirin.

Insurance:

Insurance coverage and/or out-of-pocket expenses may vary based on your diagnosis, place of service, or type of service being performed. Therefore, we strongly suggest that you contact your insurance company to determine if any personal expenses will be incurred for this service. You will be contacted by our Insurance Verification Specialist prior to your procedure if you have any upfront patient financial responsibility.
